Tuition fees	As stated in the Agreement, in point 5: Tuition fees and other costs Student exchanges deriving from this Addendum will be implemented on a "fee waiver" basis: Students at both Universities will be exempted from fees while attending the host University.
GENERAL INFORMATION FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS	
Welcome day for exchange students	The Welcome Day event is organized by our office. Approximate dates are End of September and End of February (the student will receive the communication by email).
Learning Agreement deadline	The student must send the Learning Agreement, signed by all parties, to our Office before the start of the mobility period.
Language requirements	The Language in which classes are offered at the Department is English and Italian. As indicated in the Institutional Agreement, the level of English recommended to attend course is B QCER.
Credits and exams	In Italian Universities, the minimum passing grade is 18/30. Exams with a final evaluation below 18/30 have not been passed successfully. The maximum grade is 30/30 (30/30 with honours). The credits corresponding to each academic activity is acquired by a student only when they pass an exam or another kind of learning evaluation. The Italian grading system is expressed in CFU. 1 CFU corresponds to 1 ECTS.

We suggest that students book a hostel or hotel for the first two weeks while looking for a permanent accommodation. <b>FINANCIAL MATTERS</b>	
Average expenses per month (in Euros):	Accommodation: rent is paid monthly and may range from € 250-400 for single rooms; from €350-550 for studios and about €600-750 for a two-room apartment. Food: around €250-300 per month. Transportation: €39,20 per month. Books: €150 (most of the books can be borrowed at the university libraries) Internet: €26; Phone: €20.
